



Indicative Site Layout

- A** The wood green and its surrounds will have very subtle undulations allowing for practice of shorter, level putts within the green surface and a range of short pitches from very low level mounds surrounding the green.
- B** The metal green will have more pronounced undulations than the wood green, both on the surrounds and the green surface to emulate a links style condition therefore creating larger breaking putts and more complex pitches from around the green and the bunkers.
- C** The bump & run area will start from the front of the grass range tee and consist of a series of low and high level mounds and hollows running towards and tying in to the metal green approach and surrounds. The shaping should take in to consideration the requirement for a wide range of imaginative shot options and breaking pitch shots.
- D** The range tee will be constructed in phase 2 of the development but any additional spoil material created in phase 1 should be placed here for future use.
- E** Greenhouses and garden to be re-located prior to commencement of phase 2.
- F** The bunkers should be shaped and established in the styles shown on the images below. Bunker 1 shall be smaller in size and revetted while bunker 2 shall have a rough edge with overhanging turf. Refer to Rough Grading Plan for details of areas
